



Garden Path & Border Maintenance Checklist

Use this seasonal checklist to keep your garden's paths and borders clear, beautiful, and rooted in grace. Each season has small, faithful tasks that add up to peace and beauty in your garden.

Spring

- Sweep paths clean of winter debris
- Edge garden beds for crisp definition
- Top up gravel or mulch as needed
- Check and reset frost-heaved stones

Summer

- Weed paths and borders weekly
- Trim plants spilling into walkways
- Refresh mulch to keep moisture steady
- Add stepping stones or lights if needed

Fall

- Rake leaves off paths and borders
- Repair or level shifting stones
- Add mulch before winter for protection
- Redefine edges with a spade or edger

Winter

- Keep paths clear of ice or debris
- Mark muddy or icy spots for spring fixes
- Prune lightly if plants crowd borders
- Plan improvements for spring renewal
