



Fall Brassica Transplant Checklist & Journal



Timing by Zone

- Zone 8: Transplant between August 15 and September 15
- Zone 9: Transplant between August 20 and September 30
- Zone 10: Wait until early October when night temps dip below 75°F



Soil Prep

- Add 1–2 inches of compost
- Mix in organic fertilizer high in nitrogen and phosphorus
- Add azomite or greensand for trace minerals
- Water thoroughly before transplanting
- Space plants 12–18 inches apart



Transplanting Steps

- Harden off seedlings for 5–7 days
- Transplant in evening or on a cloudy day
- Pre-moisten the planting hole
- Plant up to first true leaves
- Water deeply and mulch around the base



Troubleshooting

- Wilting? Keep soil moist and offer temporary shade
- Flea beetles or cabbage worms? Use row cover and herbs like dill or calendula
- Stunted growth? Reassess spacing, soil quality, and water
